Interview: After applications are reviewed you will be contacted to set up a personal interview date with a team of members through Camp Crosspoint. All interviews are required. After the

All Summer Staff will be required to stay at camp for some weekends. During this time, we will have a mandatory bible study on Saturday nights, and planned events for us to have fun and grow together. If there is a specific reason you will need to leave for a weekend, we will discuss that and make arrangements on a case-by-case basis. This is to build unity among us as a team. 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Positions and Dates of camp

1. Summer Staff Coordinator-- The summer staff coordinators will work closely with the Camp Crosspoint full time staff to take care of other staff. The coordinators will work closely with other summer staff to encourage, disciple, make sure they have everything they need, and to be a person to listen when something is wrong. The coordinators are head of the summer staff and sets the standard and pace for other staff.

2. Mission Coordinator-- The missions coordinator will help lead our mission's time hour, promote missions among the kids and students, and lead and share about our mission's emphasis for the summer.

3. Hospitality coordinator—The hospitality coordinator will work closely with full time staff to make sure parents know exactly what is going on, that drop-off and pick-up are easy and successful for parents, and that every child has a great experience at camp. They will also work closely with all staff to make sure they are getting what they need, and they are being taken care of each week.

4. Worship Leader-- We are looking for someone to lead worship for the entire summer. There is a huge difference between someone leading songs and being a front person and a worship leader. The worship leader must be able to teach songs, sing songs that are biblically accurate as well as fun camp songs and know when to do each, and lead in a way that points the kids/students to Christ. Some music will be provided (camp songs). The worship leader must be able to lead songs to different age groups: youth can have modern worship songs, but kids need kid songs that are doctrinally solid as well as fun. The music for the kids needs to be interactive.

5. Recreation/Night Activity Coordinator-- The recreation and night activity leader will work closely with the full-time staff to develop recreation and activities that are fun and impactful on all who come to camp.

6. Office Assistant-- The office manager will work closely with the full-time staff to help registration run smoothly and deal with phone calls and emails. The office manager will help with scheduling, placement, organization, etc. They will help make sure everything runs smoothly.

7. Skills coordinator/snack shack-- The skills coordinator will be responsible for assigning kids to their skills, posting signs, preparing skills boxes, and making sure each child gets to where they are supposed to be. They will also be responsible for making sure that each skill leader has what they need and will keep up with supplies for each skill. This person will also oversee snack shack. He/she will keep up with snack shack money taken at registration, sell snack shack, and oversee letting staff know when snack shack needs to be restocked.

8. Videographer/Photographer-- The videographer will be responsible for taking pictures/video each day and preparing an end of the week video to show at the end of the week and post at the end of the week.

9. Media Assistant-- The media coordinator will be responsible for all media components including setting up media, running media, and maintaining media during worship times. He/she will also make social media post each day and develop post to be used throughout the rest of the year to promote camp. He/she will work with the videographer to make this happen daily.

10. General Summer Staff-- The summer staff position is one of leadership and servanthood. A general staff person must be willing to do whatever, whenever, and do it with a smile on their face. The general staff will participate in many different roles over the course of the summer and must be willing to learn and adapt to any situation.

11. Lifeguard-- The lifeguard is responsible for all pool and lake activities. This person must

love kids and have a watchful eye.
